1st-5th Grade Camp Programs

Nine one-week sessions, starting June 18, 2012



Summer at GHES is a program designed for students entering grades 1st-5th. Campers will make new friends and enjoy the thrills of summer while developing their young, curious minds.

The Daily Camp Schedule Includes...

Morning Sessions

Lunch– bring from home.

Pool ~ 3 afternoons a week; Field Trip ~ every Friday; Cooking Project ~ 1 afternoon a week

Two sessions will be offered each week.

Campers will have their choice of which session to sign up for each week.

Session Descriptions are as Follows:

Summer Olympics:

Calling all countries across the world!!!! Here's our chance to show off our Olympic Pride while lighting our own version of an Olympic torch and competing in Olympic style events. Campers will pick a country to represent while going through "summer" obstacle courses, relays, and many other team building events. We will conclude the week with an awards ceremony complete with medals.

Bugs and Bees:

Learn about bugs and bees. Campers go on discovery walks to explore the lives of animals and investigate their habitats, diets, and life cycles. Back in the lab, we'll break out the microscopes and investigate their body parts. Learning will be extended by the construction of a bat box, butterfly fruit tower or a Science Journal.

Kites and Rocketry in Space:

Do you wonder how the Wright Brothers invented the airplane? If so, future aviators will love this session! We will explore the physics of flight by making paper airplanes, kites, and rocketships. We will fire off real rockets, with experimental payloads and wind permitting, we will have test flights for paper airplanes to measure distance. Soaring off into the sky will seem effortless when we are through!

Creative Chemistry:

What do you get when you mix fun, learning, curiosity, and excitement? Creative Chemistry! In this class we will learn the basics of chemistry as we make gumdrop molecules, slime, water bottle rockets, ice cream in a can, and much more! Campers will create and take home an experiment book at the end of the session so projects can be repeated at home. Don't be surprised when you hear yourself asking, "Can we do that again?" Bring your curiosity and wear experimental clothing!

Adventures with American Girls™:

Experience the magical world of an American Girl. Explore their stories and live their adventurous lives. We'll take ourselves through history as we explore the periods of time the American Girl Dolls represent. We'll sew doll accessories, bake up some sweet treats, color, craft and play games from different eras, and so much more. On the last day, we'll hold a party and invite our doll-friends and new friends to share in the fun.

Box City:

Calling all recyclers... start collecting your empty boxes now! We're building a Box City!!! In this session, we will start brainstorming about all the parts of a community and children will pick the structure they want to build. Young architects will then design their own replica of an imaginary city including stores, buildings, fire stations, roads, and restaurants and even your own dream house.

The Wonderful World of Clay:

Travel the world and explore the 3 dimensional wonders of clay! Gathering inspiration from books, pictures and music. We will travel to far away places and create projects from different regions and cultures of the world. We will make coil pots, pinch pots, and even try our hands at a pottery wheel. You will be provided with all of the materials and tools you will need to be guided by your teachers to help you create fun works of art!

Take a Shot at Photography:

Want to learn how to get that one special shot? Then this class is for you! We will jump into the world of photography by learning the basics of taking great pictures. We will learn the parts of a camera by making your own camera, experiment with lighting and zooming, and learn how to develop and display your pictures. Children will leave the session with a photo portfolio of people, landscaping and backyard nature.
*Campers will be required to bring his/her own digital camera.

Time Travelers:

If you could go back in time, where would you go? Who would you like to meet? During this session, we will travel back to a different era each day and explore different time periods such as going on a prehistoric dinosaur hunt or walk with Neil Armstrong walk on the moon. We will build time capsules and fast forward to what will happen when our great grandchildren are in school.... Or will it be a virtual classroom from home?

Drawing and Animations:

Inspired by *Diary of a Wimpy Kid!* In this session, we will learn the fundamentals of drawing, and learn the tricks of the trade to story telling, flipbooks, animation and cartooning! We will start by creating a simple picture of a character and progress to a colorful, animated production that you will be proud to share with your friends. Watch out Greg and Rowley, here we come!

Stars and Stripes:

This camp is designed for the week of 4th of July. We will go back in time to our American History and write our own Declaration of Independence, design a camp flag and elect our own camp president. And what would Independence Day be without a good old fashioned Barbeque? We will plan and prepare all the traditional American fare.... maybe we will even invite Uncle Sam!!

Lights, Camera.... Action:

Have you ever watched online videos and thought, "I can do that!" In this class, you'll get a chance to prove it. Exercise your creative muscles to come up with your own mini movie. We will take you through the whole process. Start by choosing one of our "mystery" boxes- each filled with props and story and script ideas for inspiration. As you learn your lines, you'll also have the opportunity to play theater games and record your antics for your family to watch.

FBI Detectives: A Burglary Has Been Committed!

Be part of the investigation team that processes the crime scene, finding evidence that will hopefully lead to catching the criminal. Your time will be filled with fun and excitement- learning how to take and identify different types of fingerprints, looking for clues, collecting evidence, and being part of a criminal trial. Hands on learning and guest speakers will give you a chance to learn what it is really like to process a crime scene and then take the case to trial.

Cheer and Dance:

2, 4, 6, 8, who do we appreciate? Owls, Owls, GOOO OWLS! GHES cheerleaders will come up with team names, design and create their own pom-poms, and learn a few cheers to shout at any game. We will practice healthy habits including stretching and warming up and play hip dance games all week to get their bodies wiggling. We will meet and work with some of the famous Richard Montgomery pom squad and perform a dance routine with a take home DVD.
